

CHARTER GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The following Charter General Terms and Conditions are part of the Charter Flight Quotation. Changes to these terms are valid only when confirmed in writing by Asia Corporate Jet Pte Ltd

Scope

The subject of this contractual agreement is the transport of passengers and/or goods from the point of departure to the point of destination as stated in this quotation.

1. Parties

Signature of this quotation shall, when signed by both the Customer's passengers (whether personally or through the agency of the Customer) and Asia Corporate Jet Pte Ltd, constitute a contract of carriage between the Customer and Asia Corporate Jet Pte Ltd. The Customer acknowledges on behalf of its passengers, and hereby warrants its authority to give such acknowledgement on their behalf, that no contract of carriage will exist between the Customer's individual passengers and Asia Corporate Jet Pte Ltd, notwithstanding the issue to them of a passenger ticket by Asia Corporate Jet Pte Ltd.

2. Time frame

This quotation shall, prior to its acceptance and the constitution thereby of a contract, remain open to acceptance for three weeks.

3. Aircraft-specific

This quotation is aircraft specific and is thus subject to aircraft availability. Asia Corporate Jet Pte Ltd reserves the right to at any time provide the Customer with another similar aircraft at the same cost should the offered/booked aircraft be unavailable. If no aircraft can be found Asia Corporate Jet Pte Ltd reserves the right to cancel the order.

4. Currency

This quotation is stated in the currency as indicated on page one. This quotation is subject to exchange rate fluctuations. For the purpose of this quotation the exchange rate used is that of the date of this quotation.

5. Fuel Price

This quotation is subject to industry and related fuel price fluctuations.

6. Items included in this quotation

Aircraft costs including crew, fuel and maintenance; air navigation and airport charges; handling, crew allowances; crew meals, accommodation and surface transportation; in-flight refreshment; passenger and cargo insurances and taxes.

7. Excluded Items (to be invoiced separately at cost, and reimbursed to Asia Corporate Jet Pte Ltd by the Customer)

Fuel and insurance surcharges; de-icing of aircraft; special catering requests, alcohol, including beers, wines or spirits; any other special requirements, such as limousine and satellite phone.

8. Route Changes or Delays

Should there be any route or en-route changes or delays as a result of, inter alia, the Customer's or the Customer's passengers' changed requirements; late arrival of passengers; adverse weather conditions; compliance with the requirements of international law, national legislation or subordinate legislation; unserviceability of the aircraft beyond Asia Corporate Jet Pte Ltd reasonable control; safety of the aircraft or its crew and/or safety of the Customer or its crew and/or safety of the Customer or its passengers, any costs arising from such changes or delays will be invoiced separately at cost and shall become payable by the Customer, excluding the cost of repairing the aircraft, but including the cost of arranging an alternative aircraft. Asia Corporate Jet Pte Ltd shall not be liable for any damages to the Customer or its passengers arising from any such delay.

9. Passenger and Cargo Entry Documents

All passengers have to comply with any requirements (e.g. immigration, customs, agriculture, etc.) at each destination. Passengers have to be in possession of a valid passport plus, where necessary, a visa. Asia Corporate Jet Pte Ltd takes absolutely no responsibility in the case of non-compliance with any requirement by the passenger(s). Should there be any surcharges, fees, fines or similar due to a non-compliance, the Customer will be billed for such costs. Asia Corporate Jet Pte Ltd takes absolutely no responsibility with the regard to visa requirements of its passengers. Should there be any levy imposed due to the lack of required entry documents of passengers or cargo the Customer will be billed for such costs.

10. Payment Terms

Upon your acceptance of quotation and the terms and conditions herein, an initial payment of [20]% is due and payable to reserve the aircraft for the charter period. The balance of the Total Charter Price is due no later than ten (10) days prior to the scheduled departure date.

11. Payment

The Customer shall make payment by bank transfer to the following bank account: in the name of Asia Corporate Jet Pte Ltd, United Overseas Bank Limited, UOB Orchard, 230 Orchard Road, #01-230 Faber House, Singapore 238854, Account No.217-312-8748, Swift Code UOVBSG. Major credit cards will be accepted for payments, the surcharges will be passed on to the Customer.

12. Cancellation Fees

The following fees apply should a confirmed flight be cancelled: 10-6 days prior to departure [20]%, 5-4 days prior to departure [30]%, 3-1 days prior to departure [40]%, less than 24 hours prior to departure [50]% of the total amounts or all costs of flying and expenses already incurred, whichever is greater.

13. Brokerage

Should Asia Corporate Jet Pte Ltd fly by order of a third party (brokerage), the broker and the customer are jointly and severally liable to Asia Corporate Jet Pte Ltd for the fulfilment of all payments. Asia Corporate Jet Pte Ltd offers to brokers are net and do not include any commission.

14. Passenger Baggage

Passenger baggage weight is limited for flight safety reasons and varies between aircraft type. Items determined by the crew to be of excessive weight or size will not be permitted on the aircraft.

15. Prohibited or Dangerous Goods

Dangerous goods must be declared as per dangerous goods regulations. Goods must be packaged and marked correctly according to the appropriate authorities. Copies of the relevant regulations are available from Asia Corporate Jet Pte Ltd on request.

16. Smoking

Smoking may be prohibited on some Asia Corporate Jet Pte Ltd flights depending on the individual aircraft.

17. Indemnification and Liability

Notwithstanding any passenger ticket which may be issued by Asia Corporate Jet Pte Ltd, the charterer is responsible for all passengers and consignors being aware of the following limitations:

(a) International Flights

Transportation of passengers, hand luggage, luggage and goods by Asia Corporate Jet Pte Ltd may be governed by the Warsaw Convention of 12 October 1929, as amended by the Hague Protocol of 28 September 1955 and later amendments.

(b) Domestic flights within Singapore and flights not subject to any part of the Warsaw Convention

Transportation of passengers and luggage (including hand luggage) may be limited as prescribed by the laws of Singapore

18. Indemnity

The Customer hereby indemnifies Asia Corporate Jet Pte Ltd from any claim or damage which Asia Corporate Jet Pte Ltd may suffer from the flight, other than claims or damage caused by Asia Corporate Jet Pte Ltd' own gross negligence or wilful misconduct.

19. Variation

Should any terms of this quotation be at variance with any charter; aircraft operations management; air transport; operations services; or charter agency agreement already concluded and signed between the Customer and/or the Customer's passengers and Asia Corporate Jet Pte Ltd, the terms of such agreement shall prevail over these terms.

20. Severability

Should any one or more clauses of these terms be found to be illegal or unenforceable in any respect, the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining clauses shall not in any way be affected or impaired thereby.

21. Applicable Law

These terms are governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Singapore, and subject to the jurisdiction of the Singaporean Courts.
